RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All entries must have been made on the Official Entry Forms and in the hands of the Secretary not later than Saturday 3rd JUNE 2023.
2. All exhibits must be the bona fide production of the exhibitor.
3. The marquee will be open for staging exhibits at 8.45am, and this must be completed by 10.15am. Judging will commence at 10.45am and no exhibit may be removed before 4.15pm.
4. Presentation of Cups and trophies will take place at 3.30pm in the Produce Tent.
5. Prize winners may collect prize money from the Produce Tent Stewards after the presentation of the cups on Show Day. Prize money not collected will be forfeited.
6. The Marquee will be closed to the public after 4.15pm Exhibits should be removed between 4.15pm and 4.45pm, after which any item left will be disposed of by the Stewards.
7. The Committee do not hold themselves responsible for the loss or damage to any exhibit, but all possible care will be taken.
8. No more than two entries from each competitor will be accepted in any Class in any Section. Exception being Floral Art section where only one exhibit allowed per competitor per class, except for petite class and there are no more than two.
9. The Committee will appoint judges, whose decision will be final.
10. Any complaints to be lodged with the Secretary along with a deposit of £20 before 2.30pm on the day of the Show.
11. All schools are responsible for collection of exhibits at end of the show. Failure to do so will result in exhibits being disposed.
12. The presentation of exhibits will be taken into consideration.
13. Plain labels only to be used.
14. All articles in the Handicraft Section must be unlaundered.
15. All cakes and breads will be cut.
16. For Special Awards, 3 points will be allocated for a first prize, 2 points or a second prize and 1 point for third prize. In the event of a joint placing, each competitor will be allocated the full points.
17. Any exhibits with trade names on containers may be disqualified.
18. Admission to show is £10 per adult. All competitors must pay admission when entering the field in the morning.
19. No entry fees will be charged.
20. All cookery entries will be covered after judging.
21. **PLEASE NOTE** - The marquee is situated in the same position as 2022.
Exhibitors will be unable to exit the field after staging in the morning, until after 10.00am.
